<b>Course Description:</b>	This course is a continuation of the St. Thomas Aquinas Centre for the Arts Instrumental Music program. This course will develop the student's musicianship through the jazz, latin, blues and rock and roll genres. An introduction to soloing and improvisation will be explored. Theory will largely focus on scales, intervals and triads and music listening will be done through a jazz focus.
