Course Description:	This course enables students to further develop their knowledge and skills in visual arts. Students will use the creative process to explore a wide range of themes through studio work that may include drawing, painting, sculpting, and printmaking, as well as the creation of collage, multimedia works, and works using emerging technologies. Students will use the critical analysis process when evaluating their own work and the work of others. The course may be delivered as a comprehensive program or through a program focused on a particular art form. Prerequisite: Visual Arts, Grade 9 or 10, Open
Strands/ Units:	A unified curriculum which builds art vocabulary, knowledge and understanding, thinking, problem solving, techniques and skills, and encourages analysis, judgment and expression will be developed from a selection of the following units: Unit 1 Drawing: graphite, conte, pastel Unit 2 Painting: acrylic and watercolour Unit 3 Printmaking: silkscreen printing Unit 4 Sculpture: wire Unit 5 Art History: Rococo, Neoclassicism, Romanticism, Realism, Impressionism, Post-Impressionism
