Course Description:	This rewarding advanced portfolio building course focuses on skills, and knowledge in visual and the applied arts. Students will use a technical and creative process to explore a wide range of assignments through studio work and in the field photography. Digital software and cameras will be utilized, with traditional Photography to build a creative portfolio. Students will use the critical analysis process when evaluating their own work and the work of others. Prerequisite: Grade 11 Photography
